Dear Friends,

Another church season will soon be upon us, as we prepare to enter Lent. Lent is a bit like the season of Advent, in the sense that it is a time of waiting, self-reflection, and preparation for something big. In the case of Lent, the something big for which we wait is Faster.

I enjoy Christmas, but I must admit that Easter is my favourite holiday. I love how Easter is a time of renewal, freshness, and openness to new things. I love remembering that each new moment is a fresh start, and an opportunity to start over. Most importantly, Christ shows us that no matter how bad our situations are, or how lifeless things appear to be, resurrection comes as surely as does the morning. I believe in resurrection, and that no situation or person is ultimately hopeless.

We will be having a Pastoral Charge Lenten discussion group, featuring the curriculum *Countering Pharaoh*. We will meet at Knox each Wednesday at 7 p.m. beginning on February 21. *Countering Pharaoh* is produced by the same people who produced *Living the Questions*, a progressive alternative to the *Alpha* program. Each week we will watch a short video featuring Dr. Walter Brueggemann, who is a renowned scholar of the Hebrew Scriptures, as well as a United Church of Christ minister, Dr. Brueggemann will pose a question, from which our discussion will evolve. I hope you will be able to attend this discussion group, and that it will be of use to you in your Lenten reflections.

I feel very blessed to have been welcomed in to such an open, friendly, and active community of faith. It isn't hard to see that the people of the Brookfield Pastoral Charge have hearts for others, and for service, and that is something I appreciate about you very much.
