I look forward to seeing where the Holy leads us this fall if we are willing to follow. And as we follow let us do so knowing that we aren't alone. We have each other, and God has us.



Policy for Locking Knox United Church

Effective October 1, 2019, the church building will be locked when not in active use.

A door - bell / buzzer will be installed at the South Hall door - it will sound in the ground level lobby (and in the Minister's study if the downstairs one is not audible there). This acknowledges that while many visitors come previously announced or scheduled to the Minister or Secretary, others will appear randomly, and will be welcomed by the person answering the buzzer. Signage will clearly indicate this at the north and south door entrances to the hall, and the entrance to the sanctuary.

Regular users of the building (e.g. UCW, Explorers, Music/Choir /Yoga groups,worship service tech people, Sunday School, Nox Nook, etc.) should ensure some member(s) of their group can/will provide access for their sessions and lock up afterwards. If your group needs a key to the church, please let Joanne know.
